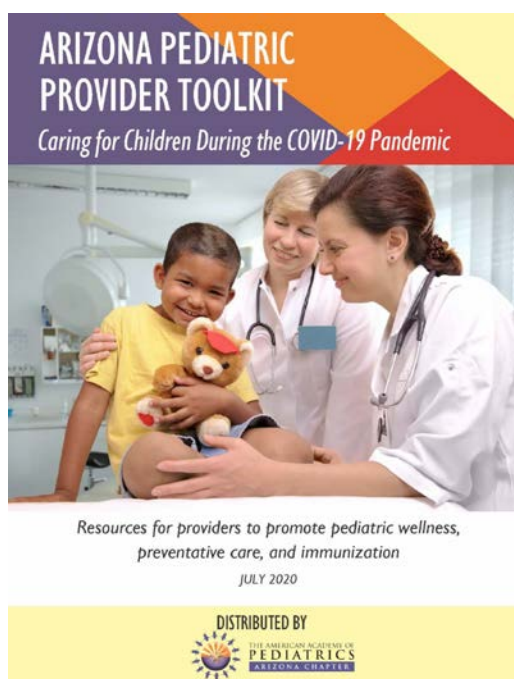


ARIZONA PEDIATRIC COVID-19 TRAINING CENTER
